A. The Director of the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) is requesting authorization to increase the existing 2014 purchase of service contract with the Running Rebels Community Organization in the amount of \$51,000 from \$1,625,944 to \$1,676,944 for services in the Delinquency and Court Services Division (DCSD) for the period June 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014.

Approval of this request will allow the DCSD Administrator to increase the capacity of the Running Rebels Targeted Monitoring Program by six slots, from the current 121 to 127, and allow DCSD the flexibility necessary to timely serve the volume of youth that the Judiciary deems appropriate for TMP services.

- B. Total 2014 expenditures included in this request are \$51,000.
- C. There is no tax levy impact associated with approval of this request in 2014 as funds sufficient to cover this expenditure are included as part of DCSD's 2014 Adopted Budget.
