 - A. In 2014, a five thousand dollar grant was included for SafeRide under the administration of the Behavioral Health Department. In 2015 these monies were not included in budget planning. The intent of this resolution is to continue to provide the monies to the SafeRide program under the Office of the Sheriff. The Department of Administrative services is authorized to process a transfer from Org. 1945 Appropriation for Contingencies to Org. 4000 Office of the Sheriff in the amount of \$5000 to offset the County's contribution to the SafeRide program.
 - B. The cost of this initiative is five thousand dollars and will come from Org. 1945. Savings to the community by providing safe rides has not been calculated.
 - C. The budgetary impact is a decrease in contingent funds by five thousand dollars. Future budgets will need to include monies for this program in order to continue the partnership.
