

WHY NOW

LPA adoption by the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors demonstrates local support for the project, a critical step for the FTA environmental review.

HOW THE LPA WAS DEVELOPED



Feasibility Study Recommendation

- Bus rapid transit
- Route, with end points at Bayshore and IKEA
- Station locations
- Mix of inside (*center*) running dedicated bus-only lanes and outside (*right*) running dedicated bus-only lanes

Conceptual Design Refinement

- Minor adjustments to routing at north and south ends to stay on public roads
- Minor station location adjustments
- Outside (*right*) running dedicated bus-only lanes

Note: Refinements continuing as additional engineering and environmental assessments are completed.

O&M cost (annual)	Operations and maintenance costs are anticipated to be cost-neutral to the MCTS system
