REQUEST

From the Executive Director of Milwaukee of County Parks, requesting authorization to expand on an already existing WE Energies easement to provide electric service to an existing gas regulation pit.

BACKGROUND

WE Energies needs to provide electric service to an existing gas regulation pit located at S. 7th Street and W. Lincoln Avenue, to energize a safety monitoring device within the gas regulation pit. Due to the number of existing utilities already present in the S. 7th Street right of way, WE Energies found no alternative location for installation of a single-phase pad-mounted transformer except on a portion of Park property on the east side of Kosciuszko Park at W. Grant Street.

There is an existing 1982 WE easement to provide electric service to the Kosciuszko Pavilion at the junction of W. Grant Street and the east property line of the park. WE Energies will connect to the existing pole, to install an underground feed and a padmounted transformer, encompassing approximately 0.012 acres of the park.

The proposed electric service and transformer do not fall within the easement area granted to WE Energies in the 1982 easement. Therefore, a new easement is required.
