SUBJECT: The Superintendent of the Community Reintegration Center (CRC) requests authorization to execute a three-year Purchase of Service Contract amendment with WestCare Wisconsin, Inc. (WC-WI) to provide Forward-Thinking sessions at the CRC. The contract will run from January 1, 2026, through December 31, 2028, contingent upon mutual agreement and satisfactory performance.

- A. Approval of this contract will authorize the Superintendent of the Community Reintegration Center to execute a three-year Purchase of Service Contract with WestCare Wisconsin, Inc. (WC-WI) to provide Forward-Thinking sessions at the CRC. The contract will run from January 1, 2026, through December 31, 2028, contingent upon mutual agreement and satisfactory performance.
- B. The total cost of the contract is variable dependent on the number of clients on electronic monitoring and is \$70,000 per year. This cost is included in the 2026 Requested Budget. This amount is intended to cover all program elements: facilitation, transportation, assessments, incentives, staff time, lead training, family services, and graduation activities.
- C. Approval of this resolution has no budgetary impact for 2026.
- D. It is assumed that the 2026 requested budget will be adopted with \$70,000 for the WestCare Wisconsin, Inc. (WC-WI) to provide Forward-Thinking sessions contract. It is also assumed that the number of clients will be consistent with the numbers from year prior.
