RE: Act 26 PSAP Grant Funding and Designation of a Primary 911 PSAP for Milwaukee County

TO: ICC Chair Bukiewicz:

FROM: Milwaukee County Police Departments with PSAPs

The Milwaukee County Police Departments that operate PSAPs do not support Act 26 grant funding going to one designated PSAP in the county. These agencies want to see any current and future grant funding to be appropriately distributed to all agencies operating a PSAP. Every PSAP is facing future costs to upgrade to Next Gen 911 capabilities. It is not equitable for all funding to go to one PSAP.

The Police Chiefs request the ICC to pursue legal assistance to determine if the provisions of Act 26 can be reversed and that grant funding can be appropriately shared.

In case the provision of one designated PSAP can not be reversed, the chiefs want to be involved in any discussion on which PSAP in the county would be the best one to receive the grant funding.
