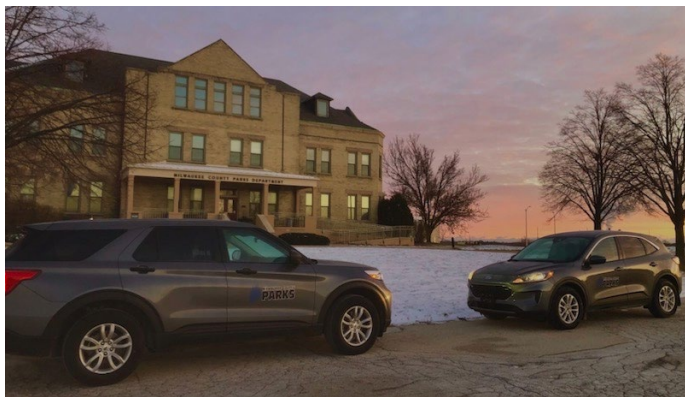

2022 After Action Report (Year in Review)

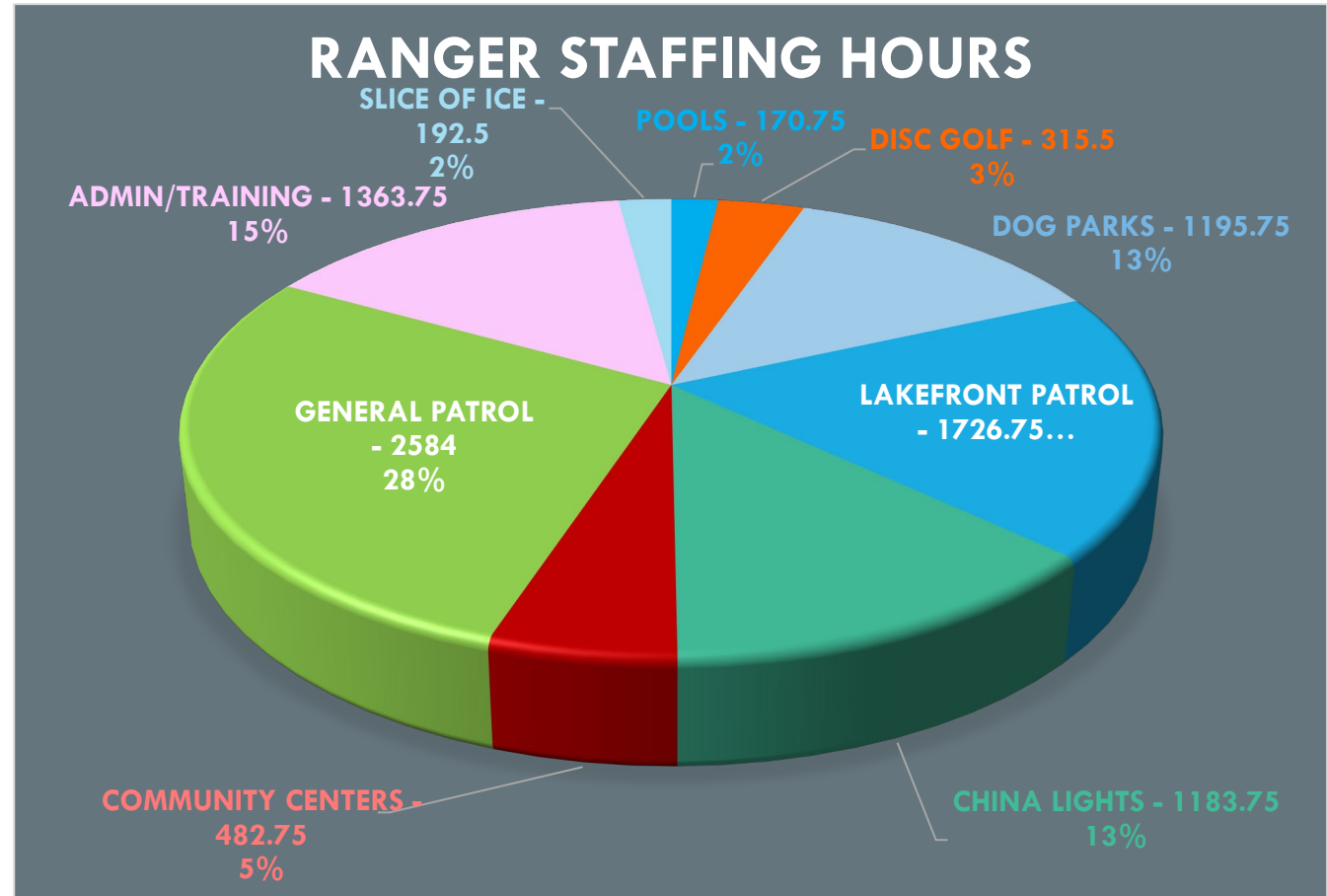
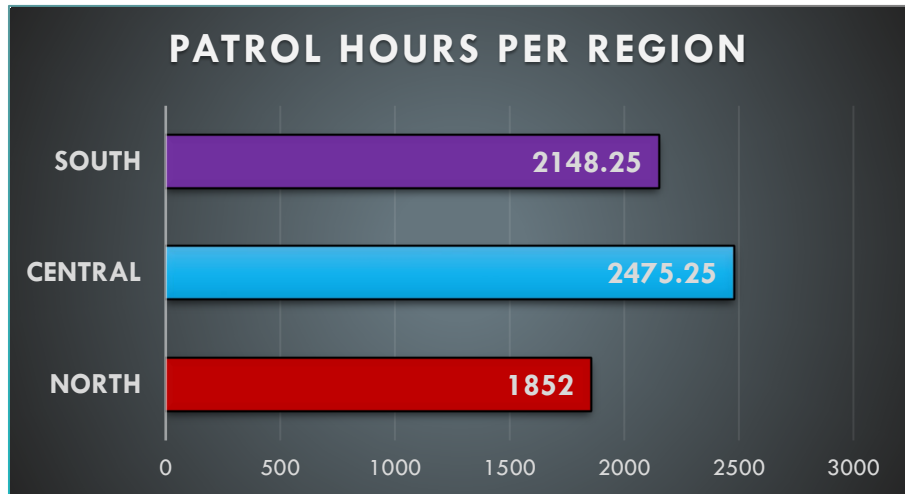


- Added Six Full-Time Rangers in 2022

PATROL HOURS

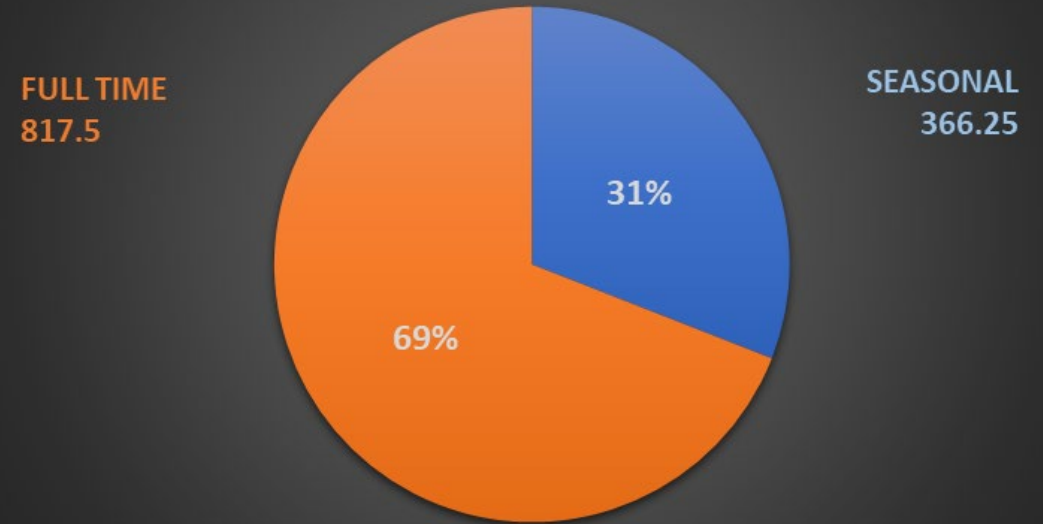
- Patrolled over 150 Parks & 15,000 acres
- Only Overtime was for China Lights* & Senior On-Call duties

- Hours spent in each region are often dictated by citizen requests, Law Enforcement assistance, Parks management and constituents, as well as trends and personal observations



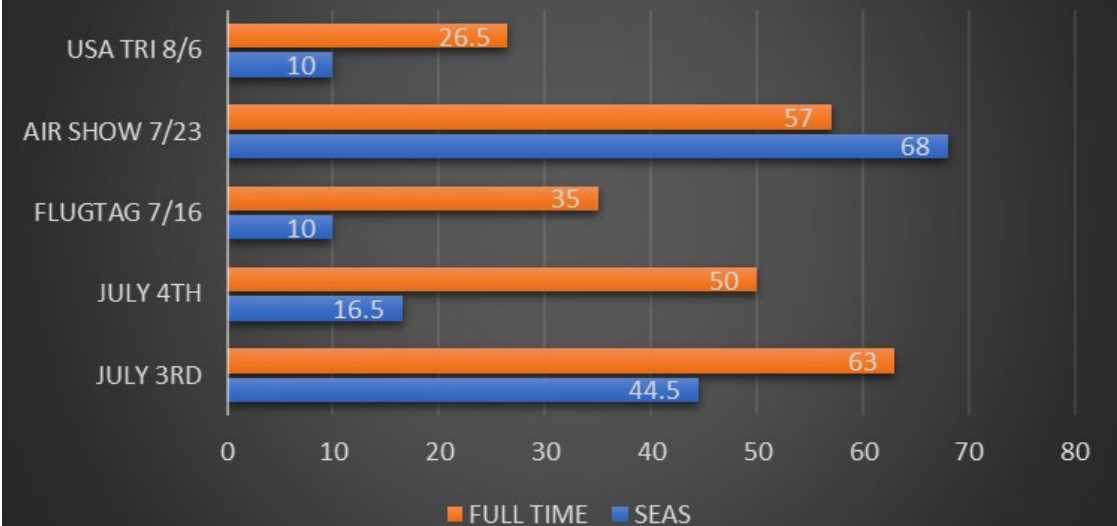

2022 CHINA LIGHTS STAFF HOURS



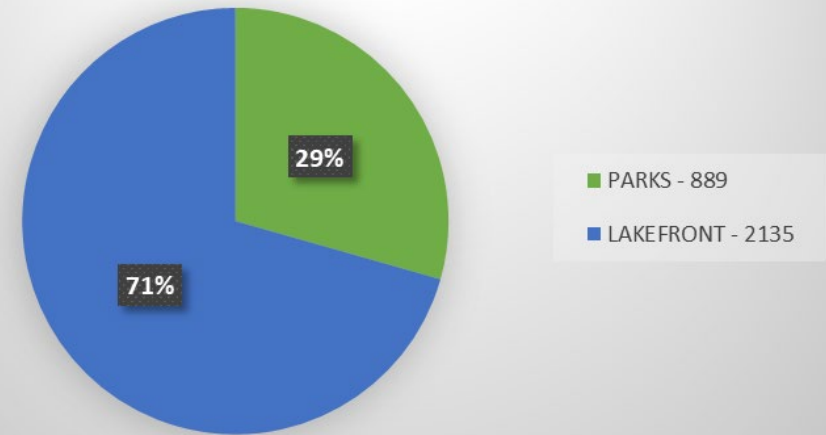
2022 RANGER EVENT PATROL HOURS



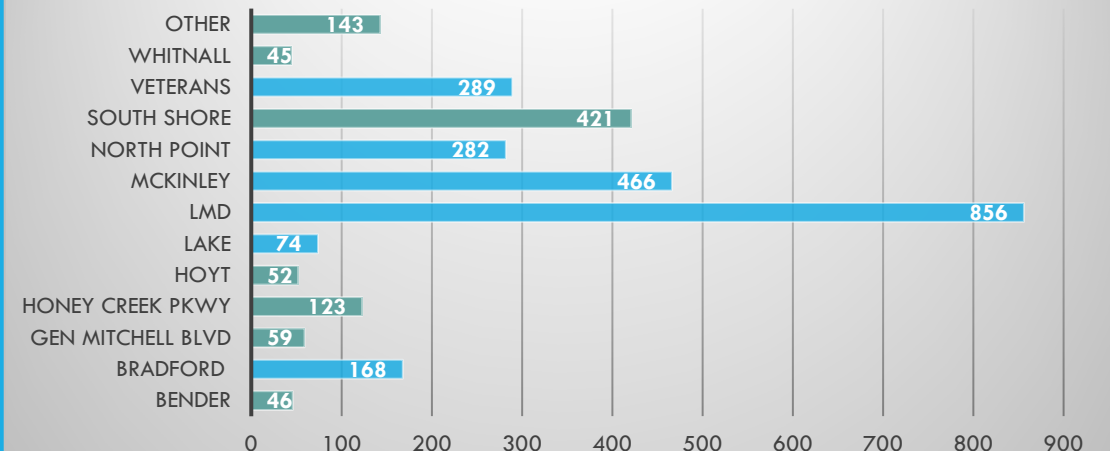
PARKING CITATIONS

- Just over 70% of Lakefront Citations were “After Parks Hours”
- Over 52% citations issued after Parks are closed
- Just over 3,000 citations issued
 - 37 issued on July 4
 - 57 issued on July 3
 - 118 issued at Airshow
- Issued citations to vehicles from 37 States
 - Wisconsin accounted for approximately 90%

PARKING CITATIONS LAKEFRONT V PARKS



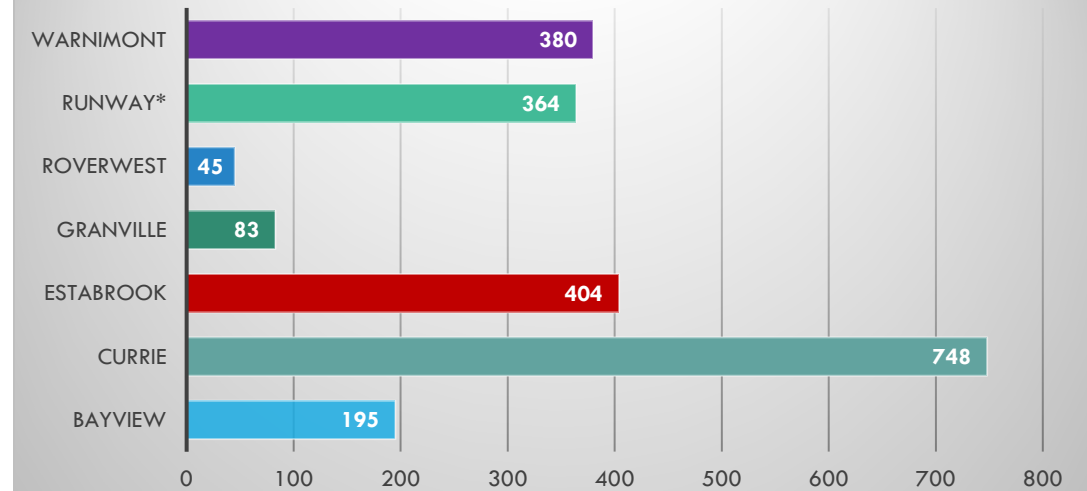
2022 PARKING CITATION LOCATION OF ISSUE



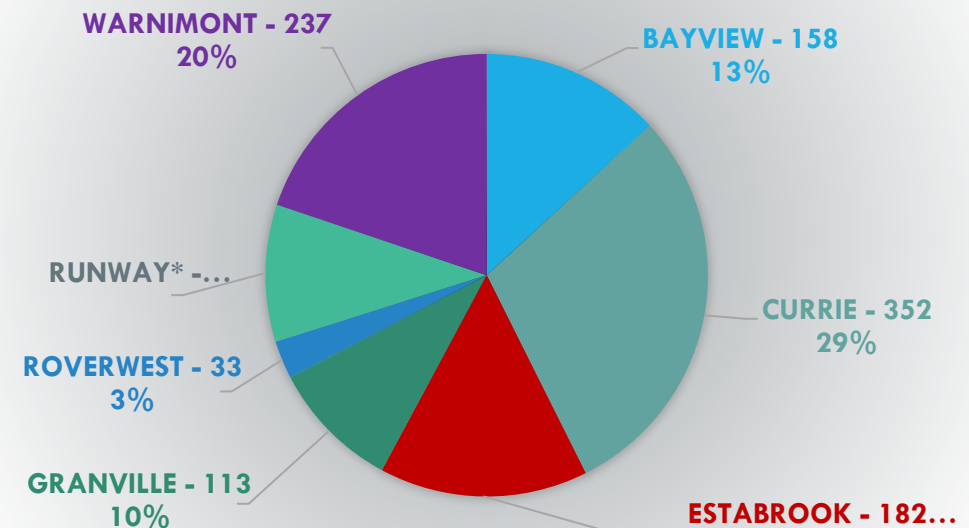
DOG EXERCISE AREAS

DEA PERMITS ISSUED



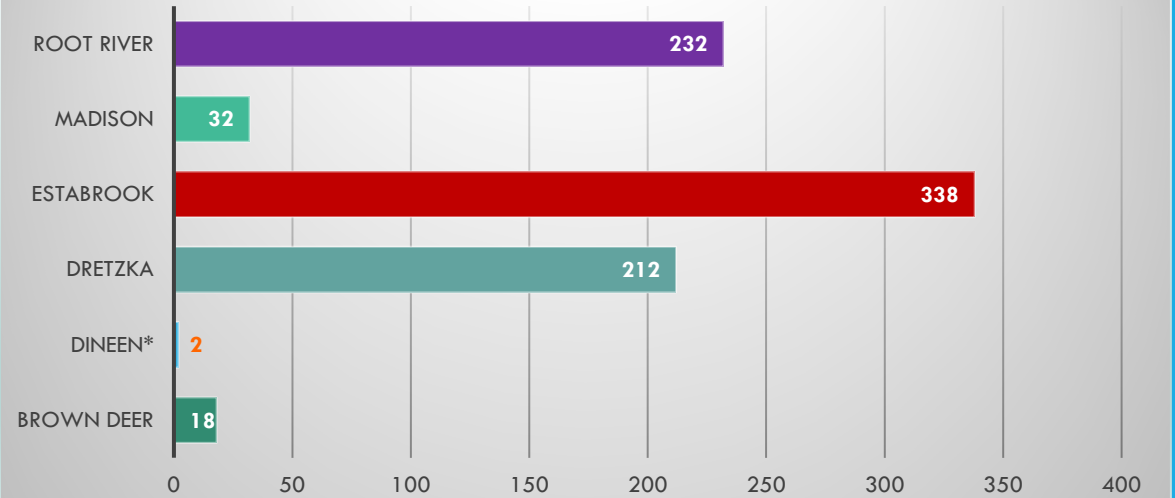
DEA FEE COMPLIANCE HOURS



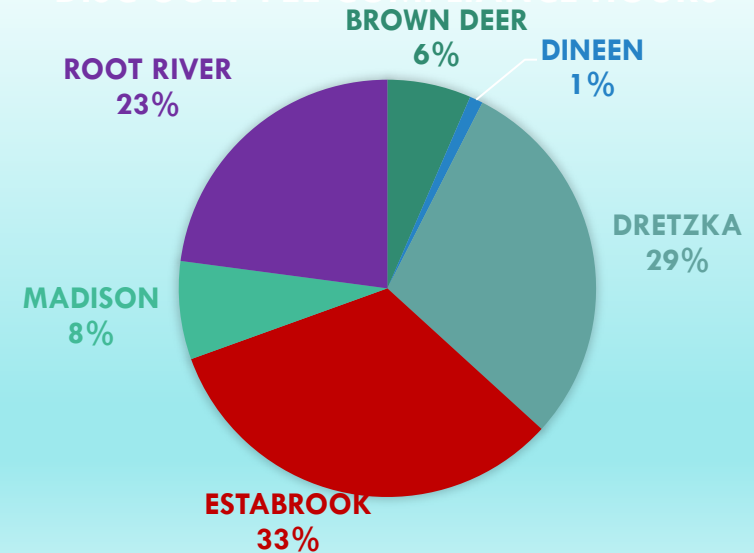
DISC GOLF

DISC GOLF FEE COMPLIANCE HOURS



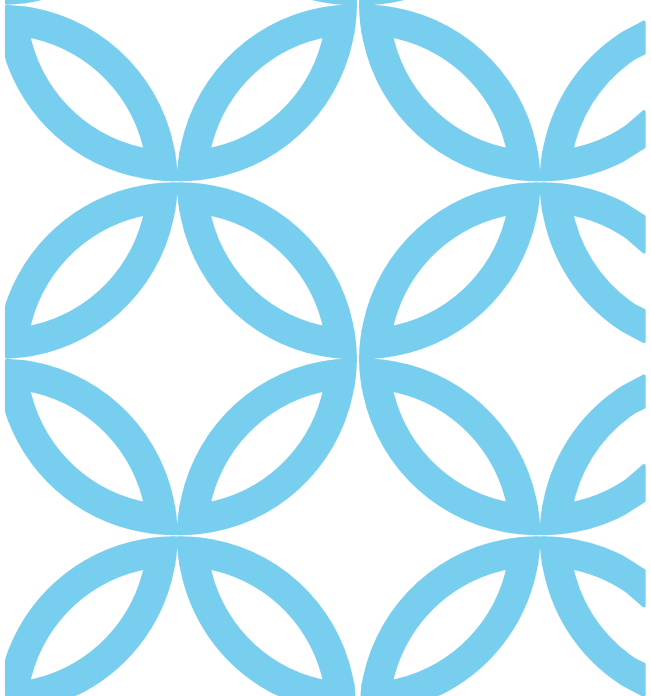
