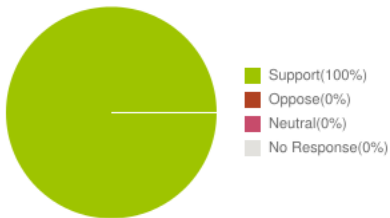

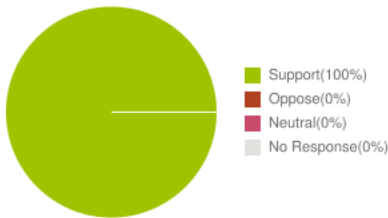

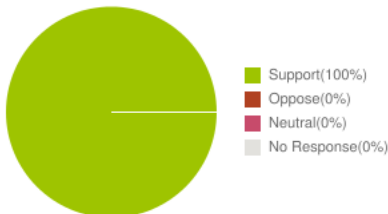
#### Overall Sentiment

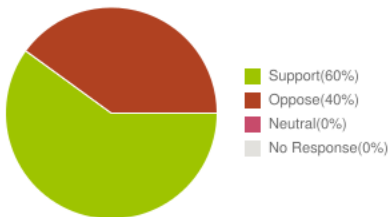

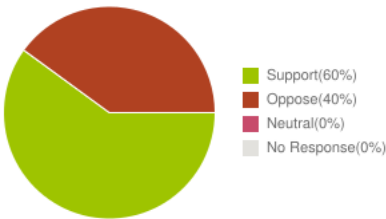

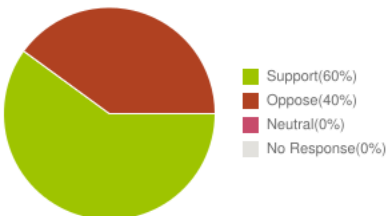
