

From the Director of Total Rewards, Department of Human Resources, requesting authorization for 1 year with Froedtert Workforce Health for three on-site employee Health Care Clinics for both Milwaukee County and Milwaukee County Transit Systems (MCTS) from January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2026, by recommending adoption of the following:

### **A RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, Milwaukee County (the County) is committed to improving the health of its employees and covered dependents; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to provide employees with on-site clinics to improve employee access to healthcare services, enhance employee productivity, reduce lost time and absence from work, improve overall health and wellbeing, and impact medical spend; and

WHEREAS, the County has seen steady improvements to its wellness program offerings since the 2014 program re-launch, including earning recognition for excellence by the Wellness Coalition of America; and

WHEREAS, Froedtert Workforce Health has been a valued partner in the successful re-launch of the County's wellness program; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Personnel, at its meeting of December 2, 2025, considered File No. 25-759 for informational purposes only per Section 59.52(31)(d), Wisconsin State Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of December 11, 2025, recommended adoption of File No. 25-759 (vote 6-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Director of Total Rewards, Department of Human Resources, is hereby authorized to execute a one-year contract with Froedtert Workforce Health for three on-site health care clinics, effective January 1, 2026, through December 31, 2026; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board) hereby authorizes and directs the Office of Strategy, Budget, and Performance (OSBP) and the Office of the Comptroller (the Comptroller) to process an administrative transfer to reallocate the estimated remaining unobligated budget balance of \$420,000 from:

- Capital Project WY011301 – On-Site Health Clinic Creation to
- Capital Project WY011302 – On-Site Health Clinic (Implementation, Management, Staff, Operations)
