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11 WHEREAS, Milwaukee County (the County) is committed to improving the health
12 of its employees and covered dependents; and

13 WHEREAS, the County desires to provide employees with on-site clinics to
14 improve employee access to healthcare services, enhance employee productivity,
15 reduce lost time and absence from work, improve overall health and wellbeing, and
16 impact medical spend; and

17 WHEREAS, the County has seen steady improvements to its wellness program
18 offerings since the 2014 program re-launch, including earning recognition for excellence
19 by the Wellness Coalition of America; and

20 WHEREAS, Froedtert Workforce Health has been a valued partner in the
21 successful re-launch of the County's wellness program; and

22 WHEREAS, the Committee on Personnel, at its meeting of December 2, 2025,
23 considered File No. 25-759 for informational purposes only per Section 59.52(31)(d),
24 Wisconsin State Statutes; and

25 WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of December 11, 2025,
26 recommended adoption of File No. 25-759 (vote 6-0); now, therefore,

27 BE IT RESOLVED, the Director of Total Rewards, Department of Human
28 Resources, is hereby authorized to execute a one-year contract with Froedtert
29 Workforce Health for three on-site health care clinics, effective January 1, 2026, through
30 December 31, 2026; and

31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors
32 (County Board) hereby authorizes and directs the Office of Strategy, Budget, and
33 Performance (OSBP) and the Office of the Comptroller (the Comptroller) to process an
34 administrative transfer to reallocate the estimated remaining unobligated budget
35 balance of \$420,000 from:
