### **REQUEST**

A report from the Director, Department of Health and Human Services, requesting approval to create 1.0 FTE Opioid Prevention Coordinator in paygrade 29M.

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## **BACKGROUND**

On December 15, 2021, the Milwaukee County Board approved File 21-1127 which authorized the Milwaukee County Office of Corporation Counsel (OCC) to enter into Settlement Agreements to receive funds from three Opioid Settlement distributors. On February 2, 2023, the Milwaukee County Board approved File 23-114 which appropriated \$11,456,094 of the Opioid Settlement Funds to finance 15 proposals to address the opioid crisis in Milwaukee County. These proposals included an Opioid Prevention Project sponsored by the Aging and Disabilities Services (ADS) with a budget of \$843,661.

The requested Opioid Prevention Coordinator is necessary to implementing this project for ADS. Specifically, the Opioid Prevention Coordinator will provide education to community partners, providers, and staff on appropriate practices and precautions when dealing with opioids and develop a system to capture prevalence, referrals, and evaluation of current

programs and practices. The position would also offer consultation on evidence-based practices that seek to support people in treatment and recovery and connect people to services as well as provide ongoing follow up when opioids are misused.

The project start date is January 1, 2023 and the project end date is December 31, 2025.
