## SHELTER CARE PROGRAM FOR BOYS

- A nurturing, safe, and supportive environment
  - Up to 20 boys at any one time
    - Ages 12-16
- Supervised 24 hours a day by Wisconsin Community Services (WCS)
  - Transportation directly to and from school
- Structured activities onsite, including mindfulness (meditation), academic tutoring, job readiness, life skills, and guided development of self-confidence and positive decision-making skills
  - Large green space (corner of 26<sup>th</sup> and Vine)
    that could be developed into a community garden or orchard
