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**REQUEST**

The Director and Chief Information Officer of Information Management Services Division, Department of Administrative Services (DAS-IMSD) is requesting authorization to abolish 1.0 FTE Senior IT Manager Applications position and create 1.0 FTE IT Manager Applications position. There is no tax levy impact to this request.

**BACKGROUND**

The DAS-IMSD Applications Team supports, maintains, and develops IT System Applications on behalf of County Departments and Staff. Within the Applications Team, the IT Application Managers oversee Application Analysts, Developers, and Architect Supervisors.

In January 2023, DAS-IMSD reclassified one IT Manager Applications to one Senior IT Manager Applications. On December 18, 2023, the individual in the Senior IT Manager Applications role was promoted to the IT Director Business Applications role. DAS-IMSD is requesting to abolish 1.0 FTE Senior IT Manager Applications position and recreate 1.0 FTE position at the IT Manager Applications level.

The Senior IT Manager Applications is a seasoned, experienced manager, who has held management positions previously. The IT Manager Applications may be staff who demonstrate management skills in previous work but may not have held a management position. The position

is responsible for effectively analyzing, planning, organizing, and leading teams in support of applications while managing risk, workload, scope, capacity, schedule, and budget. This position also works closely with project sponsors, business and technical partners, subject matter experts, end users, technical resources (internal and third-party vendors), senior management, and executives in the delivery and support of data analytics that ensure that the needs of business users are fully addressed, and continuous improvement is being achieved. The IT Manager Applications will be held accountable for ensuring that their team is meeting expectations and completing tasks.

This position was not included in the most recent Adopted Budget for two reasons: 1) the position was occupied by an experienced management professional. That individual has been promoted and a vacancy for the position has occurred. 2) This change will effectively reduce the pay range for the position.

### **ALIGNMENT TO STRATEGIC PLAN**

The creation of an IT Manager Applications would support the Department of Administrative Services – Information Management Services Division’s alignment to the strategic plan areas 2B (Break down silos across County government to maximize access to and quality of services offered) and 3B (Enhance the County’s fiscal health and sustainability).

### **FISCAL EFFECT**

The decrease in expense from the requested action will be absorbed within the adopted 2024 DAS-IMSD operating budget.
