**SUBJECT:** Authorization for MCDOT to add a "No Parking" location on South 92<sup>nd</sup> Street (CTH N) by amending Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances Chapter 69.02.

POLICY

The Wisconsin State Statutes Chapter 349.13 authorizes local authorities to establish no parking on a highway or part thereof which is under their jurisdiction. Chapter 69.02 of the Milwaukee County Ordinances establishes parking regulations for South 92<sup>nd</sup> Street (CTH N) pursuant to the authority established by the State Statute mentioned above. When the local authority determines upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that parking of vehicles adjacent to the roadway poses a hazard to the traveling public as well as the abutting property owner, such authority may elect to prohibit or restrict parking in the County Highway right-of-way.

BACKGROUND

Milwaukee County has jurisdiction of South 92<sup>nd</sup> Street (CTH N) from West Forest Home Avenue (STH 24) to the north line of West Oklahoma Avenue (CTH NN). The Transportation Services Division of the County's Department of Transportation determined during the rehabilitation of S. 92<sup>nd</sup> Street (CTH N), that there was a no parking zone that was not in the ordinances but was signed on the highway. The existing no parking zone is on the west side of the street from the limits of West Howard Avenue to the limits of West Waterford Avenue. There are two driveways to Clement Manor and one driveway to a residence in this section. Both the business and the residence have parking available on site. There are no other businesses, residences or driveways in this section of roadway. Attached is a map showing the no parking location and a support letter from the City of Greenfield.

FISCAL EFFECT

No property tax levy impact results from this action.

RECOMMENDATION

The Department of Transportation has determined that prohibiting parking on South 92<sup>nd</sup> Street (CTH N) on the west side of the street from the limits of West Howard Avenue to the limits of West Waterford Avenue should be continued. Therefore, the Director of the Milwaukee County Department of Transportation (MCDOT) recommends the County Board adopt the amended Chapter 69.02, establishing the no parking zone along South 92<sup>nd</sup> Street (CTH N).
