REQUEST

The Executive Zoo Director is requesting to abolish one position of Marketing and Events Manager to create one position of Events Manager to provide greater support to the events department, as the Zoo has added events in recent years and will continue to create additional revenue and attendance experiences.

POLICY

The maximum number of positions and/or the maximum number of employee hours in a given classification are approved as part of the annual adopted budget. Changes to the authorized number of positions outside of the budget process require approval by the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors.

BACKGROUND

The Zoo annually coordinates over 20 events, including single-day events, a month-long holiday light show, and a four-day food and music festival. The Events Manager, along with the Special Events Assistant, is responsible for planning, executing, and staffing each event, including on nights and weekends.

Creating the position of Events Manager will allow the Zoo to better facilitate the current event calendar with two dedicated event positions. Responsibilities in this department have increased significantly since adding Wild Lights in 2021. The Zoo will also be able to grow events and add programming to increase revenue and attendance.

The marketing duties of the former position will be reallocated to the advertising agency's scope of work.
