

From the Director of Compensation/Human Resources Information Systems, Department of Human Resources, requesting an increase in Constitutional Office of Sheriff Salary, in accordance with Milwaukee County Ordinance Section 17.98 for the next eligible term, by recommending adoption of the following:

**A RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, in 2019, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board) adopted an amendment to File No. 19-810, increasing compensation for the position of Milwaukee County Comptroller as a statutory elected official called for in Chapter 17.98 of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances (the Code) by 4 percent; and

WHEREAS, in 2020, the County Board approved increasing the compensation for the positions of Milwaukee County Register of Deeds, Treasurer, and County Clerk by 4 percent (File No. 20-257); and

WHEREAS, Chapter 17.98 of the Code outlines the process by which Milwaukee County can adjust the salary of certain elected officials, in accordance with Wisconsin State Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Human Resources has reviewed the salary for the position of Milwaukee County Sheriff, and is recommending the salary for the Milwaukee County Sheriff to be increased by a consistent 4 percent, effective the first day of new term after the applicable general election; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Personnel, at its meeting of January 18, 2022, recommended adoption of File No. 22-148 (vote 5-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby adopts a 4 percent salary increase for the position of Milwaukee County Sheriff, effective the first day of the applicable new term after the applicable 2022 general election:
