(ITEM) From the Director, Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture requesting authorization to apply for one or more of the following grants: State of Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Snowmobile Grant Program and National Recreation and Park Association Great Urban Parks Campaign, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture (DPRC) has identified several programs that provide funding assistance for assets and activities that support its mission “to sustain the legacy of our world-class park system by managing and conserving natural, cultural, and recreational resources for the benefit of the community”; and

WHEREAS, DPRC intends to apply for funding from the programs that present the best fit with its needs and existing financial resources; and

WHEREAS, the funding opportunities DPRC could potentially apply to include the State of Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) Snowmobile Grant Program and the National Recreation and Park Association (NRPA) Great Urban Parks Campaign; and

WHEREAS, eligible activity categories for the DNR Snowmobile Program grant are maintenance of snowmobile trails, major bridge rehabilitation, trail rehabilitation, and trail development; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project for the NRPA Great Urban Parks Campaign Grant entails a redesign of the parking lot and landscape surrounding the Pulaski Park Indoor Pool on the southern portion of Pulaski Park to incorporate green infrastructure features to achieve four outcomes:

- Capture and filtrate storm water runoff and pollutants, minimizing the flow and impact of runoff to the directly adjacent restored Kinnickinnic River
- Beautify the landscape
- Increase public use of the outdoor space surrounding the center and support community connections
- Promote environmental stewardship amongst residents

; and

WHEREAS, the ultimate goal is zero percent runoff from the indoor pool facility and parking lot, and a revitalized park; and
