

Milwaukee County Commission on Aging Aging Services Director's Report – June 2025

Administration

- Attended Milwaukee County Age Friendly Communities Steering Committee meetings and contributed data to the facilitators.
- Celebrated opening of the new Marcia P. Coggs Human Services building.
- Supported DHHS, County Executive, Parks, Economic Development and Administrative Services regarding MKE HUBS re-envisioning initiative, including data and testimony at County Board of Supervisor hearings.
- Supported recruitment of new Aging Advisory Council members.

Advocacy

- Submitted comments to the draft 2026-2028 Wisconsin State Plan on Aging.
- Hosted training on advocacy updates opportunities for Milwaukee County Aging vendors and wellness workshop facilitators.
- Onboarded one new volunteer SHIP (Medicare) Counselor; continued planning/training for volunteer SHIP counselors to host community presentations and individual counseling.
- Attended and presented on Milwaukee County aging programs and services with Transportation Coordinator at the Family Generations Expo.
- Continued planning and outreach for the "Are You Prepared?" conference with core planning team of AAA and ADRC staff.

Social Support Services

- Scored responses to the Serving Older Asylees and Refugees Request for Proposal and will recommend vendor at CoA meeting.
- Met with new Executive Director of Serving Older Adults to increase collaboration.
- Assisted vendor staff to complete program data entry into PeerPlace.

Transportation

- Training new Administrative Assistant to help with processing of OATS referrals and data entry.
- Submitted budget amendment to release county tax levy to secure local match for purchase of **3 additional accessible vehicles** through the federal FTA 5310 grant award.
- Continued to support ERAS Senior Network to implement mileage reimbursement program for their Volunteer Driver Program.



Senior Centers

- Attended community listening sessions to explore development of new senior center & affordable housing in McGovern Park.
- Facilitated tour at Kelly Senior Center for Continuum architects for the planning of a new senior center at Bucyrus Erie in South Milwaukee.
- Facilitated a listening session with Kelly senior center participants regarding the development of a new senior center & programming.
- Coordinated the repair of external cameras at McGovern senior center.

Nutrition Services

- Completed the **2025 meal cost tool** to determine actual per meal costs.
- Cooking demonstration at new Washington Park senior center kitchen.
- Initiated advanced malnutrition screening with congregate dining participants.
- Reviewing Latino and Asian inspired restaurants for Dine-Out program.

Health & Wellness

- Elected tri-chair for the Milwaukee County Falls Prevention Coalition.
- Hosted 5 heart health education sessions at Milwaukee County-owned senior centers with various partners from Wisconsin Alzheimer's Institute, Froedtert Healthcare, Progressive Health Center, and Hunger Task Force.
- Delivered tables and chairs to support new blood pressure monitor kiosks to all five Milwaukee County senior centers.
- Hosted Aging and Disability Vaccination Collaborative wrap up meetings.
- Hosted 8 Health & Wellness workshops including Boost Your Brain & Memory.

Caregiver Support

- AAA and ADRC staff are working collectively to host the "Are You Prepared event" on June 28th. This event will be a "one stop shop" for support and resources for end-of-life planning for Milwaukee County residents.
- Caregiver Support participated in the Wisconsin Aging Advocacy Network Advocacy to advocate for policies and funding to support older adults and family caregivers.
- Caregiver Support team and Dementia Care Specialists are hosting an upcoming virtual **Powerful Tools for Caregivers** course.
- The Caregiver Support Team has established 170 Caregiver Support Grants with families in 2025 as of 6/12/2025. AFCSP funds have been fully allocated to families for 2025.
