 From the Superintendent, House of Correction, requesting authorization to enter into a Professional Service Contract with Wisconsin Community Services, Inc., in the approximate amount of \$500,000 per year for electronic monitoring services for the period effective January 1, 2018, through December 31, 2020, with two one-year extension options, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the current Professional Service Contract with Wisconsin Community Services, Inc., (WCS) for electronic monitoring expires on December 31, 2017; and

WHEREAS, a Request for Proposal #98170008 was issued on June 12, 2017, and two vendors submitted proposals by the deadline of July 21, 2017; and

WHEREAS, an evaluation panel concluded that WCS, had the highest score, and also was the low cost bidder among the two firms submitting proposals; and

WHEREAS, the term of the 2018-2020 Professional Service Contract shall begin on January 1, 2018, and run through December 31, 2020, with two one-year extensions and includes the provision of continuous and non-continuous alcohol monitoring, Global Positioning System monitoring, and remote breath sensor monitoring; and

WHEREAS, this new contract is expected to result in considerable savings for Milwaukee County; and

WHEREAS, funds are sufficient and available within the House of Correction's requested budget for the 2018 portion of the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance and Audit, at its meeting of December 12, 2017, recommended adoption of File No. 17-666 (vote 7-0); now, therefore.

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize the Superintendent of the House of Correction to enter into a three-year Professional Service Contract with two, one-year extensions with Wisconsin Community Services, Inc., to provide electronic monitoring services; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the aforementioned contract will only be executed after review and approval by Community Business Development Partners, Department of Administrative Services, Corporation Counsel, the Milwaukee County Comptroller, the County Executive, and the Risk Management Division, DAS.

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
