- A. The Office of the Comptroller is requesting approval of the attached parameters resolutions for the issuance of a not-to-exceed amount of \$31,350,000 of general obligation bonds and a not-to-exceed amount of \$22,230,000 of general obligation notes to finance various capital projects that have already been approved by the County Board and County Executive. The resolutions also delegate the bid opening and approval of the winning bidder for the sales of the Obligations to the Comptroller. The Comptroller's approval is limited to sale results that fall within the parameters outlined in the resolutions.
- B. The estimated combined debt service costs for the not to exceed amount of \$31,350,000 of Corporate Purpose Bonds and \$22,230,000 of general obligation notes is \$68,703,000, including \$15,123,000 in interest.
- C. There is no current year budgetary impact since the debt payments will not begin until 2019 and the bond/note revenues are already budgeted for the individual projects. The 2019 Budget will need to include principal and interest expenses for the 2018 debt that is being issued.
- D. The costs of issuance will not exceed the federally allowable 2% of the par value of the bonds. The estimated total debt service is based on one long term financing with a 12-year term and four note financings with terms shorter than 5 years. A 5 percent coupon is assumed for the bonds and a 4 percent coupon is assumed for each of the notes series.
