**ADD AND/OR DELETE AS FOLLOWS:**

**Amend the WHEREAS clause beginning on or near line 7 as follows:**

WHEREAS, the Administration of the U.S. President Donald J. Trump announced a “zero tolerance” immigration policy in April 2018, instructing the Department of Justice to criminally prosecute all persons who illegally enter, or attempt to illegally enter, the United States of America (U.S.); and

**Amend the BE IT RESOLVED clauses as follows:**

BE IT RESOLVED, that ~~the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors~~ condemns the President’s ~~Trump Administration’s~~ “zero tolerance” immigration policy; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that ~~the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors~~ hereby supports the enforcement of the Flores Settlement Agreement and requests that the Department of Justice retract their application for relief; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that ~~the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors~~ denounces child separation practices and asks the President Trump Administration to immediately release all minor children currently in detention to their families; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that ~~the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors~~ asks Wisconsin Governor Scott Walker to recall all National Guard troops dispatched to enforce the President’s Trump Administration’s “zero tolerance” immigration policy; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Clerk is requested to furnish a copy of this resolution to ~~Government Affairs staff so that it may be communicated to~~ the President of the United States, the U.S. Attorney General, the Governor and the Milwaukee County Congressional Delegation.
