### **BACKGROUND**

Since 2003, Aurora St. Luke's Hospital ("ASLH") is Grantee of an easement from Milwaukee County Parks, for portions of the hospital facility (after its 2003 expansion) to occupy a portion of the County-owned Kinnickinnic River Parkway.

In 2016, ASLH began renovations of the facility's Sterile Processing Department, EP 3, EP 4, and Breast Imaging departments and hired The Boldt Company ("Boldt") to oversee the renovations. In 2016, Boldt applied for and received a Right of Entry permit to place a job trailer temporarily onsite. In 2016, Boldt and County Parks had presumed this would be a short-term Right-of-Entry permit. However, ASLH has not been able to provide space within the hospital facility and since 2017, Boldt has been applying for Right-of-Entry ("ROE") permits annually to retain the jobsite trailer at the parkway.

Parks has determined that it is more appropriate to enter into a lease because the temporary occupancy has developed into a longer-term occupancy that should be governed by a lease agreement. A lease would also give Parks more ability to determine an end date for Boldt's exclusive use of this portion of park land and to establish predictability.

#### **TERMS**

- Proposed Initial Term of 3 years with no more than two (2) additional one (1) year consecutive extension terms, with Parks reserving the right to renegotiate the terms and conditions at each renewal
- Lease terminates if the existing trailer requires replacement due to damage or
- Lease will establish a final removal date of no longer than 5 years from the date of execution of the lease
