

The Director of Child Support Services requests the County Board's authorization by resolution to enter into a Service Agreement with Ross Innovative Employment Services Corp to assist non-custodial parents to obtain employment through the Children First Program from January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022, with the County's option to extend in 2023, 2024, 2025 and 2026.
- B. There are no direct costs, savings, or anticipated revenues associated with this action in the current budget year or if extended, in future budget years.
- C. There is no budgetary impact associated with this agreement, as the Department has budgeted \$256,000 for this agreement in 2022, and the cost of the agreement is fully funded by the State. If the agreement is extended, \$256,000 will be factored into subsequent years' Requested Budgets.
