AN ORDINANCE

The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Milwaukee does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 17.98 - Salaries of constitutional officers, is amended as follows:

17.98: Salaries of constitutional officers.

The positions of constitutional officers within Milwaukee County include the following: sheriff, clerk of circuit court, county treasurer, register of deeds, and the county clerk. It is recognized that the incumbents of these positions serve as the department head and manager of their respective functional area and thus should be compensated accordingly in accordance with the executive compensation plan which was adopted to provide a compensation system for county managers.

Consistent with Wisconsin State Statute 59.22(1)(a), salary levels for these positions shall be established no later than December 31 of the year immediately preceding the year in which the general election for these positions is to be held. In the event no action is taken with respect to the salary levels by such date, the salary levels shall continue as previously established and maintained as follows:

(1) Sheriff - The salary rate for the position of sheriff is established at the equivalent of Rate Step 3 of ECP Salary Grade 20 and the incumbent and successor shall advance to the equivalent of the next highest rate step of ECP Salary Grade 20 annually, as of the pay period which includes the anniversary of the term of office. Effective the term of office which commences in 2003, the salary rate shall be established at the amount provided as of May 1, 2002, of the term of office that commenced in 2001 and shall remain at that rate for the remainder of the term of office.

(2) Clerk of circuit court - The salary rate for the position of clerk of circuit court is established at the equivalent of Rate Step 3 of ECP Salary Grade 18 and the incumbent and successor shall advance to the equivalent of the next highest rate step of ECP Salary Grade 18 annually, as of the pay period which includes the anniversary of the term of office. Effective the term of office which commences in 2003, the salary rate shall be established at the amount provided as of May 1, 2002, of the term of office that commenced in 2001 and shall remain at that rate for the remainder of the term of office.

(3) Treasurer - The salary rate for the position of treasurer is established at the equivalent of Rate Step 3 of ECP Salary Grade 16 and the incumbent and successor shall advance to the equivalent of the next highest rate step of ECP Salary Grade 16 annually, as of the pay

~~(5) County clerk—The salary rate for the position of county clerk is established at the equivalent of Rate Step 3 of ECP Salary Grade 16 and the incumbent and successor shall advance to the equivalent of the next highest rate step of ECP Salary Grade 16 annually, as of the pay period which includes the anniversary of the term of office. Effective the term of office which commences in 2003, the salary rate shall be established at the amount provided as of May 1, 2002, of the term of office that commenced in 2001 and shall remain at that rate for the remainder of the term of office.~~
