A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Office of the Medical Examiner has received a Comprehensive Opioid, Stimulant, and Substance Abuse Site-Based Program (COSSAP) grant; and

WHEREAS, this is a three-year Federal grant; and

WHEREAS, the Medical Examiner is requesting to use this funding to create one, Full-Time Equivalent Forensic Toxicology Laboratory Technician position; and

WHEREAS, the creation of a Forensic Toxicology Laboratory Technician position will assist in the operation of the laboratory, including sample accessioning, specimen preparation, set-up of toxicological analysis, communicating simple problem resolution, and customer service; and

WHEREAS, the position will be fully funded by the Federal COSSAP grant; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of March 18, 2021, recommended adoption of File No. 21-315 (vote 6-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes and approves the creation of one Full-Time Equivalent Forensic Toxicology Laboratory Technician position:
