2017 Initiatives

- UpLift Milwaukee
 - Employ Milwaukee
 - \$400,000 already devoted to project, requesting additional \$500,000
 - Expand outreach with mobile access hubs
 - Continue pay-for-performance model
- Youth Career Development Project
 - Collaborate with Boys and Girls Club in County Parks
 - Invest \$165,000 (\$55,000/year for 3 years) to support an additional coordinator
 - Soft skill training and job placement
