

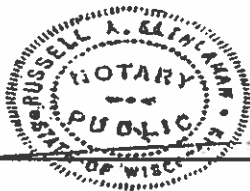

9 The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Milwaukee does ordain as follows
10
11 SECTION 1. Section 106 01 of the General Ordinances of Milwaukee County is hereby
12 amended as follows
13
14 106 01 - Purpose.
15 The Milwaukee County Commission on Youth is created to serve as a
16 representative body for youth in Milwaukee County government. The commission shall
17 work in partnership with the county board ~~and~~ the county executive ~~the community of~~
18 ~~promote~~ ~~advocacy~~ ~~annual~~ ~~and~~ ~~the~~ ~~advocacy~~ ~~annual~~ ~~for~~ ~~Milwaukee~~ ~~youth~~ ~~to~~

24 SECTION 2. Section 106 03 of the General Ordinances of Milwaukee County is
25 hereby amended as follows
26
27 106 03 - Selection of commissioners.
28 (1) Application. A candidate for the commission on youth ~~may~~ ~~shall~~ ~~request~~ ~~an~~
29 ~~application~~ ~~from~~ ~~his~~ ~~or~~ ~~her~~ ~~county~~ ~~board~~ ~~superior~~ ~~the~~ ~~county~~ ~~executive~~ ~~or~~
30 ~~access~~ ~~to~~ ~~on~~ ~~the~~ ~~county~~ ~~executive~~. Completed applications shall be submitted to
31 the county executive's office where they shall be retained until requested by the
32 selection committee. The commission has sole authority to determine when
33 applications may be submitted.
34 (2) Selection committee. Upon adoption of this ordinance, an initial selection
35 committee shall be created to select the first youth commissioners. The initial
36 selection committee will consist of two adults and three youth (age 18 or under)
37 who will be jointly appointed by the county executive and the county board
38 ~~executive chairperson~~. The initial selection committee shall review all
39 ~~applications~~ ~~by~~ ~~utilizing~~ ~~published~~ ~~criteria~~ and interview prospective
40 commissioners. The initial selection committee shall submit the names of the
41 first commissioners to the county board for confirmation. Once seated, the
42 commission on youth will appoint from within its ranks a selection committee of
43 not less than five (5) commissioners. The selection committee will determine
44 when applications may be submitted, conduct application review, interview
45 candidates, and submit names to the ~~community of~~ ~~promote~~ ~~advocacy~~ ~~annual~~ ~~for~~ ~~Milwaukee~~ ~~County~~ ~~Board~~ ~~of~~ ~~Supervisors~~
46 ~~for~~ ~~confirmation~~. In the event that an insufficient
47 number of applications are received, the remainder of the commission shall be

51 (3) Qualifications. At the time of selection, commissioners shall be a resident of
52 Milwaukee County, and shall
53 (a) Have achieved high school status,
54 (b) Currently attend high school or alternative school ~~as~~ ~~demonstrate~~ ~~the~~ ~~ability~~
55 ~~to~~ ~~attend~~ ~~a~~ ~~high~~ ~~school~~ ~~or~~ ~~alternative~~ ~~school~~ ~~and~~ ~~or~~
56 (c) Have met other qualification criteria as established by the commission under
57 106 04.
58 (4) Commission Make Up. The commission shall be made up of at least 20
59 youth including:
60 (a) At least 1 commissioner per supervisory district
61 (b) County board chairperson appointees will serve as co-chair
62 (c) County executive appointees will serve as co-chair

64 SECTION 3. Section 106 04 of the General Ordinances of Milwaukee County is
65 hereby amended as follows
66
67 106 04 - Criteria for selection.
68 The selection committee may add additional criteria in an effort to ensure that the
69 commission is reflective of both the cultural and geographic diversity of Milwaukee
70 County and ~~notwithstanding~~ ~~section~~ ~~106~~ ~~02~~ ~~11~~ ~~above~~ ~~may~~ ~~work~~ ~~with~~ ~~school~~

73 SECTION 4. Section 106 05 of the General Ordinances of Milwaukee County is
74 hereby amended as follows
75
76 106 05 - Duties; powers.
77 The duties and powers of the commission shall be as follows
78 (1) The commission shall draft, adopt, and amend its governing bylaws
79 with the assistance of the commission's adult supervisors and
80 relevant county departments and divisions,
81 (1)(2) The commission shall have the authority to receive program proposals
82 from youth groups within the county and shall have the authority to allocate
83 funds for the execution of such proposals as authorized by the county
84 board.
85 (2) The commission shall review policy and budget proposals that impact
86 youth within the county and shall provide advisory recommendations
87 to policymakers for consideration.
88 (3) The commission shall promote an annual "Take Your Child to Work
89 Day" throughout the county.
90 (4)(2) The commission shall at least annually make a report of its activities to
91 the commission on parks, energy and environment county board of
92 supervisors and the county executive.
93 (3) The commission shall designate representatives to attend the
94 community of promote advocacy annual and provide that body with a
95 periodic briefing.
96 (4)(2) The commission may assess the effectiveness of county programs
97 and services in political structure and impact on youth and
98 evaluation and implementation of the findings but not limited to
99 website and on-site visits.
100 (4)(3) The commission shall be authorized available to advise the county
101 board, and the county executive on the advisability of program advisory
102 counsel on any other matter deemed necessary to protect and promote the
103 interests of Milwaukee County youth.
104
105 SECTION 8. Section 106 07 of the General Ordinances of Milwaukee County is
106 hereby amended as follows
107
108 106 07 - Adult advisors.
109 The work of the commission shall be aided by five adult advisors.
110 (1) Composition. The chairman chairperson of the county board shall appoint
111 two (2) adult advisors, one (1) of which shall be a county supervisor, the county
112 executive shall appoint two (2) adult advisors, the commission shall appoint
113 one (1) adult advisor.
114 (2) Terms. Of the adult advisors appointed to serve the first commission, one
115 appointed by the chairman chairperson of the county board and one
116 appointed by the county executive shall each serve one (1) year. The terms of
117 the remaining three (3) adult advisors, and all adult advisors appointed
118 subsequently, shall be two (2) years. Adult advisors may be reappointed to
119 subsequent terms. The commission may recommend to the appointing
120 authority the removal of an adult advisor with a majority vote of the appointed
121 commissioners.
122 (3) Duties. Adult advisors shall assist in coordinating all training for the youth
123 commission. Adult advisors shall attend meetings of the commission as well as
124 meetings of the committees to which they are assigned. Adult advisors have no
125 voting privileges and serve only in an advisory capacity.
126
127 SECTION 8. Section 106 06 of the General Ordinances of Milwaukee County is
128 hereby amended as follows
129
130 106 06 - Length of term.
131 Of the commissioners selected by the initial review panel under [section] 106 03,
132 that of the best approximation thereof, shall be appointed to terms that end January 1,
133 2024 2024 and the balance shall be appointed to terms that end January 1, 2026 2023
134 Commissioners selected to serve an subsequent commissioners on youth shall serve a
135 maximum of (2) two-year terms.
136
137 SECTION 7. Section 106 09 of the General Ordinances of Milwaukee County is
138 hereby amended as follows
139 106 09 - Open meetings.
140 All business meetings of the commission and its consulting committees shall be
141 publicly held and open to all citizens at all times as required by § 19.81 et seq. The
142 Districts. The commission may convene and meet to conduct business remotely
143 via telephone conference video conference or other electronic communication
144 methods that the members of the district board live or otherwise reside in
145 and to the public.
146
147 SECTION 8. Section 106 10 of the General Ordinances of Milwaukee County is
148 hereby amended as follows
149
150 106 10 - Cooperation.
151 The county board shall provide for meeting rooms as may be required for the
152 conduct of commission business. All departments and divisions of county government
153 shall assist with and support the activities of the commission. The county clerk shall
154 provide staffing assistance to the commission and ensure facilitation of its
155 meetings and adherence to open meeting requirements.
156
157 SECTION 9. The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and
158 publication.
