1 Supervisor Michael Mayo, Sr., Chairperson, 2 From the Committee on Transportation, Public Works, and Transit, reporting on: 3 4 File No. 15-755 5 6) A resolution by Supervisor Mayo, Sr., authorizing the Director, (ITEM 7 Department of Transportation, in conjunction with the Milwaukee County Transit System 8 (MCTS) to reallocate \$225,000 of the \$1.5 million appropriated from the Capital Improvement Budget to implement Transit Signal Priority along the Wisconsin Avenue 9 Corridor from Downtown Milwaukee to the Medical Complex in Wauwatosa, to conduct 10 or supplement a study related to planning for Bus Rapid Transit for MCTS, by 11 12 recommending adoption of the following: 13 14 AN AMENDED RESOLUTION 15 16 WHEREAS, Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) utilizes numerous bus system 17 improvements to yield an ideal level of bus service, which improves the speed, 18 reliability, and accessibility of service; and 19 20 WHEREAS, BRT provides potential broader benefits to communities beyond 21 speed and efficiency, such as increased ridership and increased economic development 22 in areas near BRT stations; and 23 24 WHEREAS, numerous United States metropolitan areas have introduced BRT or elements of BRT, including Cleveland, Los Angeles, Seattle, and Pittsburgh; and 25 26 27 WHEREAS, Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) are a core feature of BRT as defined by the Federal Transit Administration; and 28 29 30 WHEREAS, Transit Signal Priority is a central strategy of ITS, which uses technology to enable buses to travel faster by extending green lights and shortening red 31 32 lights at intersections; and 33 34 WHEREAS, on July 30, 2015, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors 35 appropriated \$1.5 million to implement Transit Signal Priority along the Wisconsin Avenue corridor from Downtown Milwaukee to the Medical Complex in Wauwatosa, 36 37 Wisconsin, adopted in File Number 15-526; and 38 39 WHEREAS, Milwaukee County Transit System is currently preparing a multi-step 40 process for Transit Signal Priority planning; and 41 42 WHEREAS, a September 2015 report from the Director, Department of Transportation, discusses the potential operational and fiscal benefits of developing 43 Transit Signal Priority in tandem with a BRT project from Downtown Milwaukee to the 44 45 Medical Complex in Wauwatosa, Wisconsin; and 46
