 - A. Approval of this resolution will deny the proposed position reclassifications, except for one position in Org. 3010 County Clerk, submitted by the Department of Human Resources in a report dated May 27, 2016. The reclassifications are related to jobs in the departments of Human Resources and Office of Emergency Management.
 - B. The fiscal impact statement, included in the report, states the 2016 fiscal impact for salary, social security and fringe benefits for the reclassified positions as \$16,605. The full-year cost is \$30,839.
 - C. The Department of Administrative Services Fiscal Affairs Division reviewed the reclassifications and indicated that funds would be available this year in each of the affected departments to cover the cost of the position actions. Approval of the reclassifications would increase salary and fringe benefit expenditures and reduce the amount of surplus salary appropriations that may have otherwise remained at the end of the budget year. Rejection of the reclassifications will result in no additional funds needed to cover the higher cost of the reclassified positions.
