- A. Under a successful RAISE grant, MCTS Purple Line corridor improvements would include:
 - New transit shelters To improve the customer experience prior to boarding
 - Traffic signal optimization To improve transit travel times
 - Traffic calming measures To increase safety for not only transit riders, but for all modes (pedestrian, bike, automobile)
- B. The RAISE Grant is 100% federal funding up to \$25 million and requires no county match. It is anticipated that grant awards will be announced in quarter 2 of 2025. Recipients must obligate their funding by 2029.
- C. There will be no budgetary impacts in 2025. Should Milwaukee County receive the RAISE grant, ongoing maintenance and replacement of capital items will be included in future budgets.
