BACKGROUND

On April 13, 2016 Milwaukee County received from the John D. and Catherine T. MacArthur Foundation a funding award notice for the Safety and Justice Challenge Phase II Implementation grant in the amount of \$2,000,000. The award period was from May 1, 2016 to April 30, 2018. Due to the timing of the implementation of the strategies designed under the grant being behind the original schedule Milwaukee would like to increase and extend the SJC Project Manager's contract to continue the oversight, management, and fidelity to the grant. The contract will be extended for an additional 4 months, ending February 28, 2019 and the contract total shall not exceed \$164,412.

The Chief Judge recommends that the contract increase and extension for the MacArthur Safety and Justice Challenge Project Manager be authorized.
