A RESOLUTION

supporting Milwaukee County's commitment to pursuing clean energy and climate change solutions by joining the Wisconsin Local Government Climate Coalition

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Local Government Climate Coalition (WLGCC) coordinates the efforts of local governments that are pursuing clean energy and climate change solutions in Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, the WLGCC and its member municipalities work to advance climate change solutions throughout the state, with a focus on economic, health, and equity benefits associated with climate action, which disproportionately affects people of color and low-income citizens; and

WHEREAS, some of the strategies employed by the WLGCC include increased funding for energy efficiency, increased clean energy choices, increased data sharing and transparency, increased resource efficiency in new and old buildings, and a statelevel plan to retire all coal plants by 2040 and all other fossil fuel generating facilities no later than 2045, amongst many other policy initiatives; and

WHEREAS, addressing climate change requires cooperation and action across all levels and systems and, because Milwaukee County is the largest county in the state of Wisconsin, its involvement in the organization facilitates solutions for nearly one million residents: and

WHEREAS, the goals of the WLGCC align with Milwaukee County's commitment to pursuing environmentally sustainable practices throughout its facilities and operations; and

WHEREAS, Milwaukee County adopted File No. 17-506, committing to the principles and goals of the Paris Agreement for climate change awareness and the reduction of emissions that contribute to climate change; and

WHEREAS, there are no costs associated with joining the WLGCC; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Parks, Energy, and Environment, at its meeting of April 13, 2021, recommended adoption of File No. 21-390 (vote 5-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that Milwaukee County officially joins the Wisconsin Local Government Climate Coalition; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Milwaukee County is committed to advancing climate change solutions that benefit its residents and all residents in the state of Wisconsin; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Director of Sustainability, Department of Administrative Services is authorized to serve as the representative of Milwaukee County and advocate on behalf of the County to support the mission of the Wisconsin Local Government Climate Coalition.
