  - A. The Zoo is requesting authorization to enter into a second contract amendment with Dr. Taylor Bliss for veterinarian services for a term beginning on July 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024.
  - B. The total contract with Dr. Taylor Bliss is estimated at \$126,498 of which \$111,115 is estimated for 2024. The cost for 2024 is completely offset by savings from two vacant Associate Veterinarian positions.
  - C. The cost of professional services will increase by \$111,115 but the budget has sufficient funds to cover this cost from savings from two vacant Associate Veterinarian positions.
