



2026-06 Proposed Bylaw Revisions:

- 1. Add “Senior Center Committee” to the list of Standing Committees enumerated in Article V Section 1A of the Commission on Aging Bylaws as follows:**

Article V: Commission Committees
Section 1: Standing Committees
Subsection A: Establishment of Standing Committees

Addition of “the Senior Center Committee.” to the existing paragraph, to read:

The Standing Committees shall be the Executive Committee, the Advocacy Committee, the Senior Center Committee, the Service Delivery Committee, the Wellness Committee, and others as named from time to time by the Commission and shall operate in accordance with the policies and procedures prescribed by the Commission.

- 2. Remove the provision stating that a member of the Advisory Council may be appointed to any Standing Committee.** Since the Advisory Council was reconstituted, members may now include individuals who work for an entity that may have a conflict of interest if appointed to a standing committee. Deletion of this sentence avoids confusion and a potential conflict between bylaw sections, without diminishing the possibility that eligible Advisory Council members could serve on a standing committee of the commission as appropriate.

Article V: Commission Committees
Section 1: Standing Committees
Subsection B: Composition

~~(7) — A member of the Advisory Council may be appointed to any Standing Committee.~~

~~(8)~~(7) The Executive Committee shall be comprised of the Chair, Vice-Chair, Secretary, Legislative Officer, and one Commission member at-large. The at-large Commission member shall be elected to the Executive Committee by the Commission.
