

Overall Sentiment







As a long-time County resident and former Milwaukee County employee, I fully and strongly support the re-commitment to the goals of the Paris Climate Agreement. Despite the Trump administration's denial and policy misdirection, climate change remains an existential threat. We are already experiencing global impacts of climate change such as increases in vector-borne diseases, dramatic and damaging intense weather events, and prolonged droughts impacting food supplies. The direct impacts to Milwaukee County have been identified: longer, more intense heat waves, and more intense precipitation events resulting in flooding. These threats will result in loss of life and increased emergency response and recovery costs. Addressing climate change now is required of every level of government and its citizens. Public reaffirmation of the County's commitment to the Paris Agreement and its goal of net zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050 is imperative. Please vote to approve Resolution 26-338.
