Subject : Request to Transfer a Position from the Classified Service to the Unclassified Service

Request

County Board Resolution 88-757, requires departments to submit a request to transfer positions from the classified service to the unclassified service to the Director of the Division of Human Resources and to the Personnel Committee for informational purposes before submitting the request to the Civil Service Commission. The Director of the Department of Transportation and Public Works requests that the position of Resident Contract Manager (Structures), title code 77440, position number 001, be transferred from the classified service to the unclassified service.

Background/Analysis


A review of the duties and responsibilities for all positions listed indicates that the position qualifies for inclusion in the unclassified service as specified in Wisconsin State Statutes 63.03 (3)(a). The Statues require that to be in the unclassified service the position should function as a department head, deputy department heard, associate department head or immediate assistant department head. This position functions in that capacity. The other position of Resident Contract Manager that currently exists in the Department of Transportation and Public Works, Highway, title code 89720, resides in the unclassified service. Both positions are in an ECP pay range of 916E, but for some reason, the Resident Contract Manager (Structures), resides in the classified service. Now that the position is currently vacant, we are attempting to correct this issue and have both of our Resident Contact Manager positions in the unclassified service.

Recommendation

Based on the above reasons, the Director of Transportation and Public Works intends to submit an item for the Civil Service Commission agenda to transfer the position of Director of Highway Operations from the classified service to the unclassified service. Per County Board adopted policy, this item is presented to the Personnel Committee on an informational basis. No action is required.

Fiscal Effect

This action will have no fiscal effect.

PURPOSE OF POSITION: Under the direction of the Director of Highway Operations, the Resident Contract Manager – Structural Design provides managerial guidance and oversight of the Bridge Engineering area. The Bridge Engineering area of the Transportation Engineering Section provides planning, design, and construction of new bridges and rehabilitation of existing County-owned bridges. In addition, it provides consultation services to other County divisions pertaining to maintenance of County-owned buildings, parking structures, and bridges, performing mandated functions as outlined in Wisconsin State Statutes. This area, as mandated by state law, also conducts biennial bridge inspections of all County-owned bridges and administers the Local Bridge Program for all municipalities' local bridges in Milwaukee County.

design and construction of bridge or structural engineering oriented projects, including responsible supervisory experience for administrative assignments required.




