

From the Director HR Operations and Talent Acquisition, Department of Human Resources, requesting authority to retroactively accept the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation grant to create a Recruitment Outreach program, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Human Resources (HR) Operations and Talent Acquisition, Department of Human Resources (DHR), applied for a Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation (WEDC) grant (the Grant) in 2026 to expand Milwaukee County talent outreach; and

WHEREAS, HR Operations and Talent Acquisition, DHR, was awarded \$217,000 in WEDC Grant funds for a contract period of April 1, 2026, through December 31, 2026; and

WHEREAS, HR Operations and Talent Acquisition, DHR, will be recruiting eight eligible households with hard-to-fill skill sets from out of market; and

WHEREAS, WEDC requires a \$54,250 service in-kind match on the Grant, and HR Operations and Talent Acquisition, DHR, has identified \$54,250 in a fund match, or in-kind service through its existing staff; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Personnel, at its meeting of May 20, 2026, considered File No. 26-418 for informational purposes only, per Section 59.60(8), Wisconsin State Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of May 21, 2026, recommended adoption of File No. 26-418 (vote 7-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board) authorizes the Director, Human Resources Operations and Talent Acquisition, Department of Human Resources (DHR), or his designee, to retroactively accept Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation (WEDC) grant (the Grant) funds in the amount of \$217,000, with a required service in-kind match of \$54,250, to create a Talent Acquisition Outreach Program; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the County Board hereby authorizes the Office of Strategy, Budget, and Performance and the Office of the Comptroller to process an administrative appropriation transfer to direct funds to the 2026 DHR operating budget for the first year of the WEDC Grant, which reflects an amount of \$217,000.
