 - B. The annual cost for the full report is \$25,000 and \$5,000 for the update. The cost for 2025 will be \$5,000 for the update to the OPEB report. The cost for 2026 will be \$25,000 for the full OPEB report.
 - C. For 2025, the adopted budget includes the \$5,000 for the updated OPEB report. For 2026, \$25,000 will be requested for the full OPEB report.
