I'm pleased to inform you that your Pretrial Intensive Supervision Grant, 0953-39-06, entitled "Milwaukee County Intensive Supervision Grant" has been approved for an additional award amount of **\$1,079.00**. This increases your total award amount for the period beginning July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013 from \$208,478.00 to **\$209,557.00**. Please submit an amendment through the WISE grant system by May 15<sup>th</sup> 2013 in order to accept the additional award amount.

Please note the rules of your original award apply as defined in Wisconsin §85.53 as do the requirements established by BOTS:

**Reimbursement:**

- Reimbursement will be based upon the documented expenditures that do not exceed each approved budget item.
- BOTS must receive all reimbursement claims and deliverables in compliance with Wisconsin §85.53.
- Claims will not be reimbursed when there are delinquent deliverables.
- As an ISP agency receiving grant money from BOTS, you are required to participate in workgroups that address issues such as data standardization and best practices.

**Dates:** The approved project period begins July 1, 2012, and ends June 30, 2013, and only costs incurred during this period are eligible for reimbursement.

My staff and I appreciate your continued efforts to improve traffic safety in Wisconsin and look forward to working with you in the future.
