10 WHEREAS, the Milwaukee County Commission on Youth (Youth Commission)  
11 was created in 2002 to serve as a representative body for youth in Milwaukee County;  
12 and

13 WHEREAS, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board), at its  
14 meeting of May 26, 2022, unanimously adopted File No. 22-662 (vote 18-0) to  
15 re-establish the Youth Commission; and

16 WHEREAS, per adopted File No. 22-662, "Once seated, the commission on  
17 youth will appoint from within its ranks a selection committee of not less than five (5)  
18 commissioners. The selection committee will determine when applications may be  
19 submitted, conduct application reviews, interview candidates, and submit names to the  
20 county board of supervisors for confirmation"; and

21 WHEREAS, per adopted File No. 22-662, "At the time of selection,  
22 commissioners shall be a resident of Milwaukee County, and shall; have achieved high  
23 school status; currently attend high school or alternative school; and have met other  
24 qualification criteria as established by the commission under 106.04"; and

25 WHEREAS, the selection committee unanimously recommends seven Youth  
26 Commissioners to fill the seven vacant supervisory districts and requests the County  
27 Board confirm the seven Youth Commissioners; and

28 WHEREAS, the Committee on Intergovernmental Relations, at its meeting of  
29 December 1, 2025, recommended adoption of File No. 25-760 (vote 4-0); now,  
30 therefore,
