To the Board of Supervisors of the County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin:

Report on the Audit of the Schedule of Expenditures of Federal and State Awards

Opinion

We have audited the schedule of expenditures of Federal and State Awards of County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin (The County) for the year ended December 31, 2023, and the related notes to the Schedules.

In our opinion, the accompanying schedule of expenditures of Federal and State Awards presents fairly, in all material respects, the results of the County of Milwaukee's operations of Federal and State Awards of The County for the year ended December 31, 2023, in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

The financial statements of the governmental activities, the business-type activities, the aggregate discretely presented component units, each major fund, and the aggregate remaining fund information of the County, as of and for the year ended December 31, 2023, which collectively comprise the County of Milwaukee's basic financial statements have been audited and a report dated July 31, 2024 has been issued separately by other auditors.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America; the standards applicable to financial audits contained in *Government Auditing Standards* issued by the Comptroller General of the United States; and the audit requirements of Title 2 U.S. *Code of Federal Regulations* Part 200, *Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, Audit Requirements for Federal Awards* (Uniform Guidance), and provisions of the State Single Audit Guidelines issued by the Wisconsin Department of Administration. Our responsibilities under those standards and the Uniform Guidance are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Schedule section of our report.

We are required to be independent of The County and to meet our other ethical responsibilities, in accordance with the relevant ethical requirements relating to our audit. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.

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Management's Responsibility for the Schedules of Expenditures of Federal and State Awards

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the accompanying Schedules of Expenditures of Federal and State Awards in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America. This responsibility includes the design, implementation, and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of the Schedules that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditors' Responsibility

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the schedule as a whole is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance but is not absolute assurance and therefore is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards, Government Auditing Standards, the Uniform Guidance, and the State Single Audit Guidelines will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control. Misstatements are considered material if there is a substantial likelihood that, individually or in the aggregate, they would influence the judgment made by a reasonable user based on the schedule.

In performing an audit in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards, the Uniform Guidance, and the state Single Audit Guidelines, we:

- Exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit.
- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the schedule, whether due to fraud or error, and design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks. Such procedures include examining, on a test basis, evidence regarding the amounts and disclosures in the schedule.
- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the County's internal control. Accordingly, no such opinion is expressed.



• Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of significant accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluate the overall presentation of the schedule.

INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT ON COMPLIANCE FOR EACH MAJOR FEDERAL AND MAJOR STATE PROGRAM AND REPORT ON INTERNAL CONTROL OVER COMPLIANCE AS REQUIRED BY THE UNIFORM GUIDANCE AND THE STATE OF WISCONSIN SINGLE AUDIT GUIDELINES

To the Board of Supervisors of the County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin

Report on Compliance for Each Major Federal and Major State Program

Opinion on Each Major Federal and State Program

We have audited the County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin's (The County) compliance with the types of compliance requirements identified as subject to audit in the OMB *Compliance Supplement* and the State of Wisconsin ("State") Single Audit Guidelines that could have a direct and material effect on each of The County's major federal and state programs for the year ended December 31, 2023. The County's major federal and state programs are identified in the summary of auditor's results section of the accompanying Schedule of Findings and Questioned Costs.

In our opinion, The County complied, in all material respects, with the types of compliance requirements referred to above that could have a direct and material effect on each of its major federal and state programs for the year ended December 31, 2023.

Basis for Opinion on Each Major Federal and State Program

We conducted our audit of compliance in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America; the standards applicable to financial audits contained in *Government Auditing Standards*, issued by the Comptroller General of the United States; and the audit requirements of Title 2 U.S. *Code of Federal Regulations* Part 200, *Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, Audit Requirements for Federal Awards* (Uniform Guidance), and the State Single Audit Guidelines. Our responsibilities under those standards, the Uniform Guidance, and the State Single Audit Guidelines are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of Compliance section of our report.

We are required to be independent of The County and to meet our other ethical responsibilities, in accordance with relevant ethical requirements relating to our audit. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion on compliance for each major federal and state program. Our audit does not provide a legal determination of The County's compliance with the compliance requirements referred to above.

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Management's Responsibility

Management is responsible for compliance with the requirements referred to above and for the design, implementation, and maintenance of effective internal control over compliance with the requirements of laws, statutes, regulations, rules, and provisions of contracts or grant agreements applicable to The County's federal and state programs.

Auditor's Responsibility

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether material noncompliance with the compliance requirements referred to above occurred, whether due to fraud or error, and express an opinion on The County's compliance based on our audit. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance but is not absolute assurance and therefore is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards, Government Auditing Standards, the Uniform Guidance, and the State Single Audit Guidelines will always detect material noncompliance when it exists. The risk of not detecting material noncompliance resulting from fraud is higher than for that resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control. Noncompliance with the compliance requirements referred to above is considered material if there is a substantial likelihood that, individually or in the aggregate, it would influence the judgment made by a reasonable user of the report on compliance about The County's compliance with the requirements of each major federal and state program as a whole.

In performing an audit in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards, Government Auditing Standards, the Uniform Guidance, and the State Single Audit Guidelines, we:

- Exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit.
- Identify and assess the risks of material noncompliance, whether due to fraud or error, and design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks. Such procedures include examining, on a test basis, evidence regarding The County's compliance with the compliance requirements referred to above and performing such other procedures as we considered necessary in the circumstances.
- Obtain an understanding of The County's internal control over compliance relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances and to test and report on internal control over compliance in accordance with the Uniform Guidance and the State Single Audit Guidelines, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of The County's internal control over compliance. Accordingly, no such opinion is expressed.



We are required to communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and any significant deficiencies and material weaknesses in internal control over compliance that we identified during the audit.

Report on Internal Control Over Compliance

A *deficiency in internal control over compliance* exists when the design or operation of a control over compliance does not allow management or employees, in the normal course of performing their assigned functions, to prevent, or detect and correct, noncompliance with a type of compliance requirement of a federal and state program on a timely basis. A *material weakness in internal control over compliance* is a deficiency, or a combination of deficiencies, in internal control over compliance requirement of a federal and state program will not be prevented, or detected and corrected, on a timely basis. A *significant deficiency in internal control over compliance* is a deficiency, or a combination of deficiencies, in internal control over compliance is a deficiency or a combination of a federal and state program will not be prevented, or detected and corrected, on a timely basis. Our audit was not designed for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of internal control over compliance. Accordingly, no such opinion is expressed.

The purpose of this report on internal control over compliance is solely to describe the scope of our testing of internal control over compliance and the results of that testing based on the requirements of the Uniform Guidance and the State Single Audit Guidelines. Accordingly, this report is not suitable for any other purpose.

Report on Internal Control Over Financial Reporting and on Compliance and Other Matters Based on an Audit of Financial Statements Performed in Accordance With Government Auditing Standards

Independent Auditors' Report

To the Board of Supervisors of County of Milwaukee

We have audited, in accordance with the auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America and the standards applicable to financial audits contained in Government Auditing Standards issued by the Comptroller General of the United States, the financial statements of the governmental activities, the businesstype activities, the aggregate discretely presented component units, each major fund, and the aggregate remaining fund information of the County of Milwaukee, (the County) as of and for the year ended December 31, 2023, and the related notes to the financial statements, which collectively comprise the County's basic financial statements, and have issued our report thereon dated July 31, 2024. Our report includes a reference to other auditors who audited the financial statements of the Milwaukee County War Memorial, Inc. and the Marcus Center of the Performing Arts, as described in our report on the County's financial statements. The financial statements of the Milwaukee Public Museum, Inc., the Milwaukee County War Memorial, Inc. and the Marcus Center of the Performing Arts were not audited in accordance with Government Auditing Standards, and accordingly, this report does not include reporting on internal control over financial reporting or compliance and other matters associated with the Milwaukee Public Museum, Inc., the Milwaukee County War Memorial, Inc. and the Marcus Center of the Performing Arts. Our report also includes a reference to other auditors who audited the financial statements of the Employees' Retirement System of the County of Milwaukee, as described in our report on the County's financial statements. This report does not include the results of the other auditors' testing of internal control over financial reporting or compliance and other matters that are reported on separately by those auditors.

Report on Internal Control Over Financial Reporting

In planning and performing our audit of the financial statements, we considered the County's internal control over financial reporting (internal control) as a basis for designing audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances for the purpose of expressing our opinions on the financial statements, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the County's internal control. Accordingly, we do not express an opinion on the effectiveness of the County's internal control.

A *deficiency in internal control* exists when the design or operation of a control does not allow management or employees, in the normal course of performing their assigned functions, to prevent, or detect and correct, misstatements on a timely basis. A *material weakness* is a deficiency, or a combination of deficiencies, in internal control, such that there is a reasonable possibility that a material misstatement of the entity's financial statements will not be prevented, or detected and corrected, on a timely basis. A *significant deficiency* is a deficiency, or a combination of deficiencies, in internal control that is less severe than a material weakness, yet important enough to merit attention by those charged with governance.

Baker Tilly Advisory Group, LP and Baker Tilly US, LLP, trading as Baker Tilly, are members of the global network of Baker Tilly International Ltd., the members of which are separate and independent legal entities. Baker Tilly US, LLP is a licensed CPA firm that provides assurance services to its clients. Baker Tilly Advisory Group, LP and its subsidiary entities provide tax and consulting services to their clients and are not licensed CPA firms. Our consideration of internal control was for the limited purpose described in the first paragraph of this section and was not designed to identify all deficiencies in internal control that might be material weaknesses or significant deficiencies and therefore, material weaknesses or significant deficiencies may exist that were not identified. We identified a deficiency in internal control, described in the accompanying schedule of findings and questioned costs as item 2023-001, that we consider to be a material weakness.

Report on Compliance and Other Matters

As part of obtaining reasonable assurance about whether the County's financial statements are free from material misstatement, we performed tests of its compliance with certain provisions of laws, regulations, contracts, and grant agreements, noncompliance with which could have a direct and material effect on the financial statements. However, providing an opinion on compliance with those provisions was not an objective of our audit, and accordingly, we do not express such an opinion. The results of our tests disclosed no instances of noncompliance or other matters that are required to be reported under *Government Auditing Standards*.

The County's Response to Finding

Government Auditing Standards requires the auditor to perform limited procedures on the County's response to the finding identified in our audit and described in the accompanying schedule of findings and questioned costs. The County's response was not subjected to the other auditing procedures applied in the audit of the financial statements and, accordingly, we express no opinion on it.

Purpose of This Report

The purpose of this report is solely to describe the scope of our testing of internal control and compliance and the results of that testing, and not to provide an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control or on compliance. This report is an integral part of an audit performed in accordance with *Government Auditing Standards* in considering the entity's internal control and compliance. Accordingly, this communication is not suitable for any other purpose.

NOTES TO SCHEDULES OF EXPENDITURES OF FEDERAL AND STATE AWARDS

YEAR ENDED DECEMBER 31, 2023

1. SCOPE OF AUDIT

The County of Milwaukee (County) is a governmental entity established by laws of the State of Wisconsin and has the powers of a body corporate, as defined in the Statutes. All significant operations of the County are included in the scope of the Single Audit in accordance with the provisions of Title 2 U.S. Code of Federal Regulations Part 200, Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards (Uniform Guidance), and the State Single Audit Guidelines issued by the State of Wisconsin, Department of Administration. The U.S. Department of Transportation has been designated as the County's cognizant agency for the Single Audit.

(a) Programs Subject to Single Audit

All Federal awards received by the County directly from the Federal government or passed through the State of Wisconsin have been included in the Schedules of Expenditures of Federal Awards. All State Awards received by the County have been included in the Schedules of Expenditures of State Awards.

(b) Fiscal Period Audited

Single Audit testing procedures were performed for program transactions occurring during the calendar year ended December 31, 2023.

2. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

(a) Accrued and Deferred Balances

Revenues (which include grantor reimbursement and local funding) are reported on the cash basis of accounting, whereas expenditures are reported on the accrual basis. The difference between the reported revenues and expenditures can result in accrued or deferred balances at the end of the year. These balances are reversed in subsequent periods.

The following statement applies to the Department of Health and Human Services – Behavioral Health Department, Department of Health and Human Services – Housing Division, Milwaukee County Department of Transportation – Airport, Department of Parks, Recreation and Culture, Sheriff Department, Department of Administrative Services – Architecture and Engineering Services, and the Office of Emergency Management.

The 2023 Single Audit Report identifies corrections necessary to the beginning balance reported in 2023 from the ending balance in the 2022 Single Audit Report. Each project contains the 2022 ending balance reported in 2022, the adjusted amount for the correction and the correct amount at the start of 2023. As these balances reverse in subsequent years, making this one-time adjustment brings all the projects in line for the end of 2023.

(b) Sub grantees

Certain program funds are passed through the County to subgrantee organizations. The Schedules of Expenditures of Awards do not contain separate schedules disclosing how the subgrantees outside of the County's control utilized the funds. The County requires subgrantees receiving funding to submit separate audit reports disclosing the use of program funds.

(c) <u>Cost Allocation</u>

The County has a plan for allocation of central service costs related to grant programs. The amounts allocated to grant programs during a fiscal year are based on this cost allocation plan. Variances between actual costs and budgeted amounts are corrected on a prospective basis. As a result, the 2023 Cost Allocation Plan was based on the 2021 actual amounts and includes adjustments for variances between the 2021 Plan and the 2021 actual amounts.

In addition to the cost allocation plan, the County has various departments, which provide services to other County departments. Charges between departments are based upon direct rates. The methodology or basis for these direct rates has been reviewed and approved by representatives of the Federal Transportation Administration – Department of Transportation.

(d) De Minimis Election

Milwaukee County has elected not to use the 10% de minimis cost rate.

(a) Title XIX Medical Assistance payments to the Behavioral Health Division for 2023 and 2022 amounted to \$95,633,366 and \$103,993,607 respectively. These amounts consisted of the following items:

- (b) Program income was received mainly in the form of principal and interest payments from home rehabilitation loans to lower-income occupants. The original home repair loans were funded by Community Development Block Grants (CDBG) and Home Investment Partnership (HOME), which originated from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. CDBG and HOME program income of \$47,001 and \$271,998 respectively was received from these loans in 2023.
- (c) According to the State of Wisconsin, Department of Children and Families, 2023 Youth Aids-State payments for correctional facility charges were \$9,524,084. This amount is unaudited and is presented as additional information to satisfy disclosure requirements established by the State of Wisconsin, Department of Health and Family Services.

Section II—Financial Statement Findings

Finding 2023-001 – Material Weakness - Internal Controls Over Financial Reporting

Criteria: Auditing Standards require the communication to the Board of Supervisors of significant deficiencies and material weaknesses in the year-end financial reporting process.

Condition: The Office of the Comptroller had key personnel turnover prior to finalization of yearend reconciliation and year-end reporting. This led to the identification of material journal entries that were identified as part of the audit process to correct the financial reporting of the County.

Cause: The Office of the Comptroller had key personnel turnover prior to finalization of year end reconciliation and year end reporting.

Effect: Year-end financial reporting (financial statements and footnotes) would have been materially misstated and not presented in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles without the identification by the external auditor of the necessary correcting journal entries.

Recommendation: The County should evaluate the closing procedures and controls for the year-end reconciliations and year-end reporting within the Office of the Comptroller starting with a focus on the reporting areas that had material journal entries. In addition, a continued emphasis and enforcement of the individual County department's compliance with the year-end closing calendar may help to improve these procedures and controls.

Planned Corrective Action:

Milwaukee County concurs with this finding and recommendation. In order to ensure that the closing process, including proper preparation and documentation of journal entries, produces an accurate and timely trial balance before submission to the external auditors, the following actions will be undertaken:

3rd Quarter 2024

- 1) Complete recruitment and hire for the newly upgraded position of Accounting Manager with a highly qualified candidate.
- 2) Revise closing procedures and calendar with the goal of creating a more structured closing process.
- 3) Review and update process documentation to reduce the potential for misstatements in the initial financial statements
- 4) Provide additional cross training for Central Accounting staff to enhance flexibility of task assignment.
- 5) Design a training and communication plan for the updated closing process and calendar.

4th Quarter 2024

- 1) Communicate the new closing process and calendar to all countywide financial staff.
- 2) Train Central Accounting staff and departmental financial staff on new process, schedule and expectations. Determine any needs for additional support.
- 3) Continue process documentation and Central Accounting staff cross training.
- 4) Review and update process documentation.

1st Quarter 2025

- 1) Improve communication and deadline enforcement with contributing departments to improve the timeliness and quality of data and supporting documentation submitted.
- 2) Improve communication procedures between county staff and external auditors.

2nd Quarter 2025 and future

- 1) Revisit and if necessary, revise the action plan to ensure proper on-going implementation.
- 2) Undertaking the above actions should improve the County's ability to weather inevitable staffing turnover and create a more stable closing process.
