There are no budget implications associated with the current year. However, implementation of Recommendation No. 5 of the audit report suggests that Transit Plus management "Include in its next solicitation of van service proposals a requirement that vans are equipped with continuous surveillance cameras suitable for assisting in investigations of disputed service complaints," increasing the successful vendor's costs an estimated \$300,000 - \$800,000. The extent to which this would impact Transit Plus Program operating costs is dependent on the level of competition for the contract(s) when they are next put out for bid, anticipated to be in late 2015.
