Administration

- Milwaukee County Age Friendly Communities Steering Committee.
- Transitioned into to new Marcia P. Coggs Human Services building.
- Met w/ WI-DHS regarding implementation of new ACL regulations and potential changes in support and funding at the federal level.
- Supported DHHS, County Executive, Parks, Economic Development and Administrative Services regarding MKE HUBS re-envisioning initiative.
- Worked with fiscal team to submit the 180B Older Americans Act report.
- Supported recruitment of new Aging Advisory Council members.

Advocacy

- Coordinated the 2025 Senior Leadership program.
- Facilitated older adult participation in Wisconsin Aging Advocacy Day to meet with state legislators to advocate for our state budget priorities.
- Drafted letter to Congressional delegation to support Older Americans Act, and continued support of a unified federal Administration on Aging.
- Supported Commission on Aging /AARP forum on Social Security.
- Worked collectively with advocates across Wisconsin to eliminate means testing for Alzheimer's Family and Caregiver Support Program to increase access and allow AFCSP funds to be used as match for NFCSP funds.
- Reviewed and commented on Wisconsin draft State Plan on Aging.
- Planned conference to assist with end of life decision-making.

Transportation

- Developed plan to secure local match to initiate purchase of 3 additional accessible vehicles through the federal FTA 5310 grant award.
- Supported ERAS Senior Network to implement mileage reimbursement program for their Volunteer Driver Program.

- Attended community listening sessions to explore development of new senior center & affordable housing in McGovern Park.
- Facilitated tour at Kelly Senior Center for Continuum architects for the planning of a new senior center at Bucyrus Erie in South Milwaukee.

- Coordinated the repair of external cameras at McGovern senior center.
