  - A. The action being requested is extension of a TAHC for Mr. Dennis Dietscher to the position of Risk Manager for a 90 day period from November 1, 2011 through January 29, 2012. If the TAHC is not extended, Mr. Dietscher would return to his current position as Employee Safety Coordinator, however, the Risk Manager would become vacant.
  - B. The direct costs of this action are additional salary expense of \$3,630 in 2011 and \$1,726 in the subsequent year (should the position not be filled by 2011 year-end). The Risk Manager position is currently being recruited, therefore, the TAHC for Mr. Dietscher may end prior to January 29, 2012.
  - C. The total cost of the requested TAHC of \$5,355 can be absorbed within the DAS-Risk Management Budget.
  - D. The analysis assumes that the requested TAHC will extend from November 1, 2011 through January 29, 2012.
