10 AN ORDINANCE

12 The Board of Supervisors of the County of Milwaukee does hereby ordain as
13 follows:
14

15 **SECTION 1.** Section 1.14 (b) of the General Ordinances of Milwaukee County is
16 amended as follows:
17

- 18 (b) *Committee report laid over on request.* Action on the report of any committee as
19 defined in subsection (a) of this section, when it first makes its report, shall be
20 deferred until the next meeting of the county board if one-third (1/3) of the
21 members present and voting so request. If the report of said committee is re-
22 referred to said committee or any other committee and thereafter the subject
23 matter is again returned to the county board, action thereon shall not be deferred
24 except as provided by section 1.15 or by a majority vote of the members present.

26 The above rule shall not apply to the report of the committee on finance,
27 ~~personnel~~, and audit on the executive budget, including resolutions proposing tax
28 levies and recommendations on new positions to become effective in and
29 included in the budget for the following fiscal year. The rule shall also not apply to
30 passive review public contracts subject to ss. 59.52(31)(b)(1) and (2) Wis. Stats.
31 or county executive appointment confirmations subject to s. 59.17(2)(b)(1) Wis.
32 Stats.

34 **SECTION 2.** Section 1.15 of the General Ordinances of Milwaukee County is amended
35 as follows:
36

37 **1.15. - Referring resolution, ordinance or report for legal opinion.**
38

39 With the affirmative vote of one-third (1/3) of the members present and voting at
40 any meeting of the county board, any resolution, ordinance or report shall be referred to
41 the corporation counsel and the written opinion of the latter secured as to the legality of
42 the resolution or ordinance offered, or the recommendation made in any report
43 presented to the county board for adoption. Such opinion shall be rendered to the
44 county board at its next meeting held not less than forty-eight (48) hours after the
45 referral, and copies distributed to all members. The resolution, ordinance or report, shall

46 not be re-referred again to the corporation counsel for a legal opinion except by a
47 majority vote of the members present.

49 The above rule shall not apply to:

51 (1) The report of the committee on finance, ~~personnel~~, and audit on the
52 executive budget.

54 (2) Resolutions proposing amendments to the executive budget.

56 (3) Resolutions proposing tax levies.
57
58 (4) Recommendations of the committee on finance, ~~personnel~~, and audit on
59 new positions to become effective in, and to be included in, the budget for
60 the following fiscal year.

62 (5) Passive review public contracts subject to s. 59.52 (31)(b)(1) and (2) Wis.
63 Stats.

65 (6) County executive appointment confirmations subject to s. 59.17(2)(b)(1)
66 Wis. Stats.

68 **SECTION 3.** The provisions of this amended ordinance shall be effective upon passage
69 and publication.
