State of WI ARPA Funded Categories

Enhance Pretrial GPS Supervision to 24/7 Monitoring (Two Years)	Pretrial Services to add a second shift and third shift case manager
Expand Courthouse Operations by 5 Courts (Two Years)	Funding will be allocated to support the expanded staff needs of the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office, State Public Defender, Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office, and Clerk of Courts. Funds will also cover required courtroom build-outs/security enhancements.
Pilot Extended Courthouse Operations into the Evening Hours	Covers required overtime expenditures - for the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office and Clerk of Courts - to pilot two evening courts, twice per week.
Formalize Mental Health Treatment Court (Two Years)	Funds the hiring of a Treatment Court Coordinator to lead the planning and formalization of a mental health treatment court. Funds are also allocated to create a psychiatry fellowship partnership.
Enhance Employment and Vocational Preparedness Programs at the Milwaukee County House of Correction (One Year)	The Milwaukee County House of Correction will partner with Employ Milwaukee to provide pre-employment, cognitive behavioral therapy, and connections to post-employment resources using a trauma informed care approach. Providing for additional reentry services, particularly industry-recognized training, to begin while participants are still incarcerated and to continue post-release, can help HOC eliminate the time gap between release and enrolling into reentry programming and/or immediate employment for inmates. Inmates that do not recidivate will not return to HOC, reducing operational costs.
