The district attorney's office is requesting the creation of 2.0 FTE positions – a victim/witness advocate in the domestic violence unit at the Sojourner Family Peace Center and a sensitive crimes victim advocate in the sensitive crimes unit – and approximately \$3,496 in computer equipment for the new positions, to implement a Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) grant award of \$142,940 (114,353 federal funds + \$28,587 local match), as authorized by the County Board in the May 2016 cycle. Legistar File No. 16-309.

Creation of the 2.0 FTE new VOCA positions will have no 2016 tax levy effect because the district attorney's office should be able to absorb the estimated local match expenses of \$4,882 within its 2016 operating budget, on the assumption the new positions will not be filled until November 7, 2016, at the earliest. No appropriation of funds is required in the 2016 budget. The district attorney's office will request funding for the new positions in the 2017 budget, including the estimated 2017 local match expenses of \$23,705.
