SUBJECT : Ordinance Changes included in 2018 Adopted Budget

The 2018 Adopted budget includes an admission fee increase of \$1.25 effective April 1, 2018 in all admission categories. The Zoo requests that the attached resolution/ordinance be adopted to align the revenues approved in the 2018 budget with fees outlined in Chapter 47.32 of the General Ordinances.

The resolution/ordinance also corrects the fees for non-resident and resident group adult and child admission fees. The 2017 fees for group rates was \$10.25 for adults and \$7.25 for children. With the \$1.25 fee increase effective April 1, 2018, the fees will be \$11.50 and \$8.50 respectively. The ordinance incorrectly had these rates at \$12.00 and \$9.00.
