

Report from the Director, Department of Health and Human Services, requesting authorization to enter into 2024 professional service contracts with community vendors for Children, Youth and Family Services, by recommending adoption of the following:

A REVISED RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, per Section 59.52(31) Wisconsin State Statutes, the Director, Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS), is requesting authorization to enter into 2024 Professional Service Contracts (the Contracts) for Children, Youth, and Family Services (CYFS); and

WHEREAS, the Contracts reflect the procurement of the following services to support both the youth residing in the detention center, as well as CYFS-DHHS staff, detention physician and medical services, and detention psychiatric nursing, as well as medical and pharmaceutical supplies and medications; and

WHEREAS, there is no budgetary impact associated with this request, as funding for these contracts totaling \$384,096, is included in the 2024 Adopted Budget; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of December 14, 2023, recommended adoption of File No. 23-968 (vote 5-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Director, Department of Health and Human Services, or her designee, is hereby authorized to enter into Professional Services Contracts in the amount of \$384,096, with the following organizations for the period January 1, 2024, through December 31, 2024, in the amounts and terms enumerated as follows:
