(ITEM) From the Director of Employee Relations, Department of Human Resources, requesting ratification of the 2015 Memorandum of Agreement between Milwaukee County and the Milwaukee Building & Construction Trades Council, American Federation of Labor-Congress of Industrial Organizations, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the negotiation staff of Milwaukee County and the Milwaukee Building & Construction Trades Council, American Federation of Labor-Congress of Industrial Organizations (AFL-CIO), have reached agreement on all issues relating to wages, for employees in the bargaining unit represented by the Milwaukee Building & Construction Trades Council, AFL-CIO, for the period effective January 1, 2015, through December 31, 2015, modifying the previous agreement in the following respects:

- (1) Providing for the termination of the Agreement on December 31, 2015.
- (2) Providing for effective Pay Period 14, 2015, (June 21, 2015) wages of the bargaining unit employees shall be increased by one and one-half percent (1.5%).

; and

WHEREAS, such Agreement was ratified by the membership of the Milwaukee Building & Construction Trades Council, AFL-CIO, on January 4, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, Personnel, and Audit, at its meeting of January 28, 2016, recommended adoption of the Director of Employee Relations' request (vote 7-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby approves the Agreement on wages, with the Milwaukee Building & Construction Trades Council, American Federation of Labor-Congress of Industrial Organizations, which is incorporated herein by reference to this File No. 16-82, and hereby authorizes and directs the County Executive and the County Clerk to execute the Agreement; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Director, Department of Administrative Services, is hereby authorized and directed to complete an appropriation transfer reflecting this Agreement as necessary.
